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1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest definitions under MSME rules, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.
2. If the bidder is a Startup, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. 4. Experience Criteria: In respect of the filter applied for experience criteria, the Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through reseller(s)} should have regularly, manufactured and supplied same or similar Category Products to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU for number of Financial years as indicated above in the bid document before the bid opening date. Copies of relevant contracts to be submitted along with bid in support of having supplied some quantity during each of the Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category of primary product having highest value should meet this criterion.
5. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. 6. Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted, while evaluating the bid. 1. Authorised Service Centre within the state of Odisha, along with a dedicated contact person with telephone number for technical solution in a fast track basis at this institution as and when required basis.
2. Experience Certificate for the supply of the same to any Govt/ PSU/ any renowned private organisation along with Supply/ Purchase Order.
3. If the agency is registered under MSME or NSIC, then EMD exemption certificate needs to be enclosed.

1. **An office of the service provider must be located in the state of consignee and documentary proof in this regard must be attached.**
2. **The Bidders should compulsorily visit, inspect and examine the site to understand the scope of work and submit site survey report duly countersigned by the Maintenance staff at the Tiruvallur field unit and must be attached under technical specification documents in GeM portal.**
3. **Tenderers are required mandatorily to submit attested copies of Sales Tax/GST registration & PAN card.**

- 4. The Bidder must submit an undertaking for acceptance of terms and conditions of the bid document under Annexure-1 and also submit checklist in the attached format in this bid**
- 5. The bidders document is liable to be rejected in case of non-receipt of the documents mentioned in the bid document.**
6. Tenderers have to quote their rates (inclusive of GST) both in figure and in words.
7. The Bidder should not sub-let or sub-contract the work to sub-Bidders or to any single sub-Bidder.
8. The Bidders have to engage technically qualified and license person for supervision of the work to be executed under this tender. The said person has to supervise or work during the entire period of execution of the work under this tender. Furnishing of certificates/ license of the said supervisor may be furnished to concerned section before execution of the work.
9. The Bidder should have the experience of having successfully completed similar works during the last 3 (Three) years. Work Experience in other field such as Electrical/Mechanical works will not be treated as similar work experience. Hence, it must be noted that those Bidders who do not have requisite experience need not participate in the tender and their bids will be summarily rejected or will not be evaluated for this tender.
10. Bidders/ Contractors/ Firms are to submit experience certificate/ documents of similar works.
11. Bidders have executed similar works in any of the Central Govt. Department/ State Govt. Department/ Companies of repute. Bidders should have experience of having successfully completed similar works during last 3 years ending last day of month previous to the one in which applications are invited should be either of the following:-
 - a. Three similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to 40% of the estimated cost
 - Or
 - b. Two similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to 50% of the estimated cost.
 - Or
 - c. One similar completed work costing not less than the amount equal to 80% of the estimated cost.
12. All applicable taxes will be deducted at source.
13. During the execution of the work, the Bidder shall keep the site reasonably free from all unnecessary obstructions and shall store or dispose of any of their equipment or surplus materials and clear any wreckage, rubbish or temporary works from the site in consultation with the Engineer-in-charge of the Institute. Bill/payment for Bidders will be processed only after cleaning of site.
14. The Bidder while employing laborers and workmen should ensure that all the statutory labour laws, Minimum Wages Act, EPFO and ESIC and regulation are adhered to.
15. The Defect Liability Period (hereafter DLP) will be one year and will be reckoned from the date of completion of the work and issuing of a certificate to this effect or as decided by the Institute. The bidder shall have to attend complaints related to non-working of items supplied and installed under this tender during the said DLP of one year. Bidders shall have to furnish details of contact person(s), his/ her/ their contact number(s), postal address, email id for communication of such complaint(s) by Institute's officials.
16. The total number of days for completion is 60 days from the date of issue of letter of award/work order.
17. The Institute reserves the right to accept or reject any or all tenders without assigning any reasons thereof.
18. All disputes shall be within the jurisdiction of Courts at Chennai.

19. The Bidder shall be responsible for the safety of all its workmen/employees during the period of execution of the work. The Bidder shall provide all safety materials, gadgets, equipment etc. to all its workmen/ employees to ensure their safety during execution of the work. The Institute shall not be held responsible in case of any accidents, mishaps etc. to the party/bidder and its employees.
20. During execution of work under this tender, any injury or loss of life of employees/workmen deployed by the bidder due to negligence or any other reason will be sole responsibility of bidder and Institute's officials will be indemnified against such injury or loss of life of employees/workmen deployed by the bidder.
21. The successful bidders must submit Performance Bank Guarantee at the rate of 3% of the total value of the contract awarded in favour of "The Director, NIRT" payable at Chennai. The PBG will be returned only after 60 days of completion of all contractual obligations by the bidder.
22. Any delay/incompletion of the works beyond the stipulated date due to reasons attributable to the Bidder may eventually lead to cancellation of letter of award for which the Bidder is not entitled to any compensation. The cancellation of letter of award would lead to forfeiture of performance security.
23. If the Bidder fails to complete the execution of the work (except due to unavoidable and/or unforeseen circumstances and/or due to some bonafide reasons acceptable to ICMR-National Institute for Research in Tuberculosis) as specified in the work order and/ or beyond extension period (if extension of time is granted by ICMR-National Institute for Research in Tuberculosis, Chennai), the Bidder shall be bound to pay liquidated damages (hereafter LD) as a sum of 0.5% per week of delay for such default subject to a maximum of 10% (i.e. 20 weeks after scheduled date of completion of work/ allowed extension period) of the contract price. LD can be deducted from the final bill of the bidder. If bidder fails to complete the work even after 20 weeks from scheduled date of completion of work/allowed extension period, then Performance Security amount will be forfeited without any further consideration on the bidder's request. ICMR-National Institute for Research in Tuberculosis, Chennai reserves the right to not entertain any claim for prorated and/or part payment of partly completed work which will be at the sole risk and responsibilities of the bidder. Payment will be made only after satisfactory completion of work based on the recommendations of the Maintenance Department of the Institute.
24. The Bidder shall not be permitted to take back the items supplied and/or installed by Bidder if he/she/they fail(s) to complete the execution of work (in totality) under this tender. No request will be entertained in this regard.
25. No accommodation will be provided by ICMR-National Institute for Research in Tuberculosis, Chennai. Bidders have to make arrangement for accommodation for their employees on their own. However, ICMR-National Institute for Research in Tuberculosis, Chennai will provide temporary space free of cost for storing of material and tools only required for execution of the work under this tender.
26. If at any stage it will be found that any of the bidder(s) [participated in this tender] has/have furnished false/forged documents or adopted any fraudulent methods to get this tender then the said bidder(s) will be disqualified for participation in the future tenders published by ICMR-National Institute for Research in Tuberculosis, Chennai or Bidders will be black listed for any business relationship in future with ICMR-National Institute for Research in Tuberculosis.
27. No advance payment will be given to the contractor for mobilizing material and/or manpower for execution of work in this tender.
28. The contractor has to coordinate with the officials of the Institute at every stage of the work for the proper execution of the required work.
29. RATES:
- a) The Tenderer are required to quote BASE RATES inclusive of GST as mentioned in price offer. All base rates (inclusive of GST) will be treated as firm for entire period of the contract arrangement and extension if opted by the Corporation. No enhancement in rates will be allowed for any reason whatsoever, during the contract period /extension period, if opted.

b) Quotation should be for FREE DELIVERY of material at ICMR-National Institute for Research in Tuberculosis, Chennai "All Inclusive Basis". Rates should include handling charges, delivery charges & other incidental charges (if applicable) inclusive of GST.

c) Tenderer are requested to indicate their best rates together with maximum discount in the very first instance since further negotiations after opening price offers is entirely at the discretion of the authorities and may or may not take place.

d) Tenderer are advised to exercise greatest care in entering the rates. No excuse that mistakes have been made or requests for rates to be corrected will be entertained after the quotations are opened. All corrections, if any, should be initiated by the person signing the tender form before submission, failing which the rates for such items may not be considered.

30. TAX CLAUSE AS PER GOODS & SERVICES TAX (GST):

1. Registration & GST Rate: Bidder should indicate GSTIN No. (Copy of GST registration to be enclosed) and PAN No. (Copy of PAN to be enclosed) 2. Tender will be considered/accepted, if & only if the vendor has a valid GST Registration No.

2. All the terms & conditions of the contract with respect to taxes & duties are subject to the new taxation laws introduced from time to time (e.g. GST). The terms & conditions will be modified in accordance with the provisions of new laws (e.g. GST). The prices quoted above must be inclusive of all taxes and GST.

While participating in bid, Bidder has to undertake compliance of this and any false declaration and non-compliance of this would be a ground for immediate termination of the contract and further legal action in accordance with the laws./जेम की सामान्य शर्तों के खंड 26 के संदर्भ में भारत के साथ भूमि सीमा साझा करने वाले देश के बिडर से खरीद पर प्रतिबंध के संबंध में भारत के साथ भूमि सीमा साझा करने वाले देश का कोई भी बिडर इस निविदा में बिड देने के लिए तभी पात्र होगा जब वह बिड देने वाला सक्षम प्राधिकारी के पास पंजीकृत हो। बिड में भाग लेते समय बिडर को इसका अनुपालन करना होगा और कोई भी गलत घोषणा किए जाने व इसका अनुपालन न करने पर अनुबंध को तत्काल समाप्त करने और कानून के अनुसार आगे की कानूनी कार्रवाई का आधार होगा।
